# IN THE GOSPEL TODAY

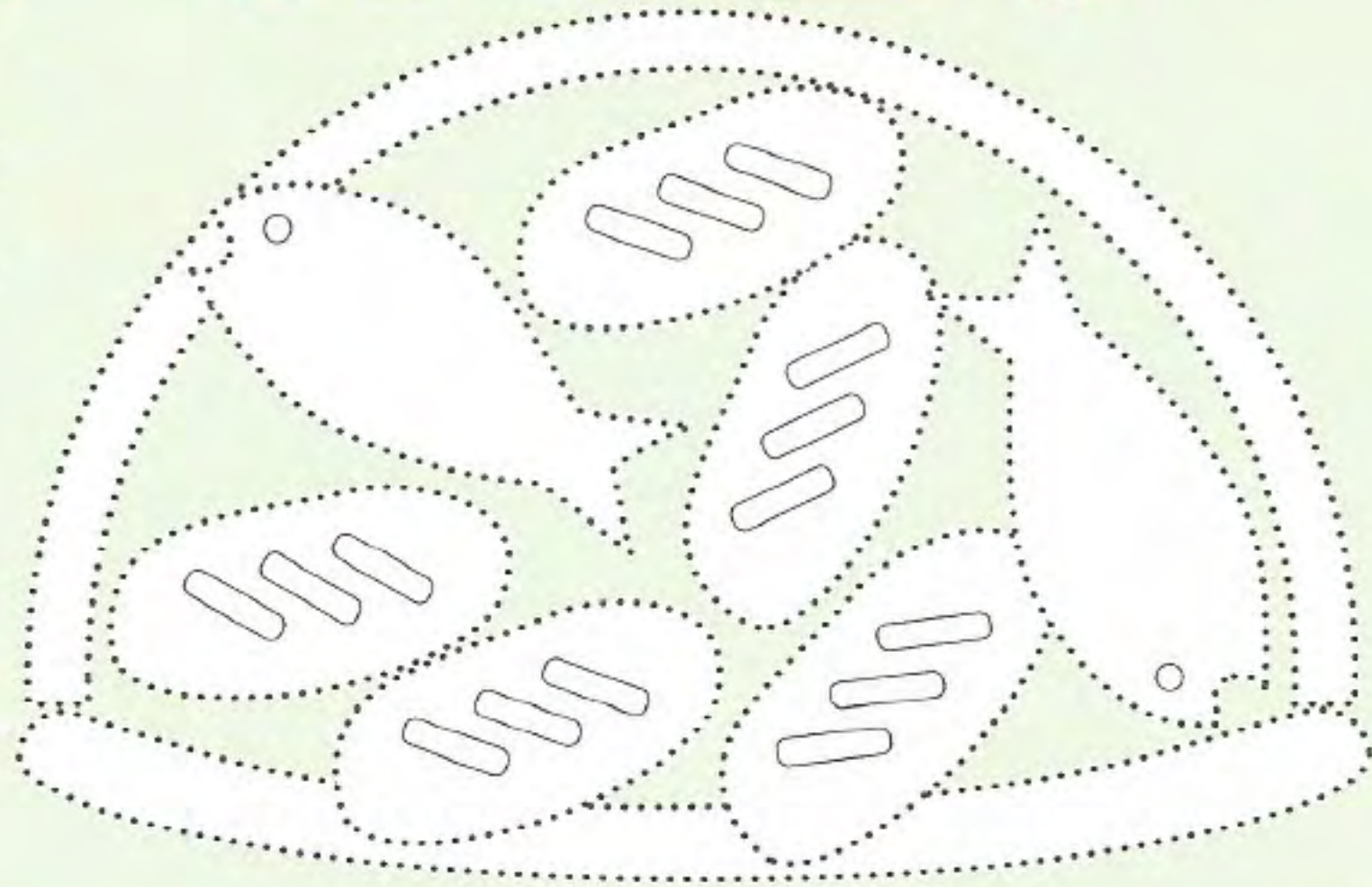
